2. Letter of recommendation: Please select an individual who can speak to your ability to be successful in graduate education. Please ask them to include specific information as to your capacity for success as a nurse educator. This may be an employer or former faculty member.
3. Submission of Transcript. Please submit transcripts of any and all undergraduate and post-graduate education.

Scholarship Program:

1. Scholarship program is funded by The Research Foundation. Compensation for each year will be up to \$2,500 for a period not to exceed 5 years for a total amount of \$5,000. The period of one-year may be defined as beginning in the fall, continuing through spring and summer. For each \$2,500 utilized, the individual is required to commit one-year of employment as a full-time faculty member in the Greater Kansas City community following the completion of the MSN.
2. Scholarship applications are accepted throughout the year.
